5	Children of Non-teaching staff under category No:1 in the Diocesan institutions, diocesan organizations and the Diocesan office <i>(Certificate to be submitted from the head of institution / organization / office concerned)</i>	3		
6	Spouse and unmarried children of Church worker up to the grade of Evangelist <i>(Certificate to be submitted from the district minister concerned)</i>	3		
7	Age	20	Those who have completed 30 years of age – 5 credits, 1 additional credit per year up to 45 years.	
8	Weightage	No ceiling	1 credit per year from the date of obtaining the badge.
